EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

Winnecke advised ETSB office is operating under an alternating remote schedule of only two employees in the office every other day. New EnRoute Mobile is deployed and being used in several departments. A new version has been released which resolved some previous issues reported by departments with additional development in progress for both law and fire. Text to 9-1-1 implementation is in its final stages. ETSB is currently coordinating with Solacom for training on the system. A press release will be coordinated to inform the public of Text to 9-1-1 being available and the appropriate use. The Central Square Portal Hub project is moving forward and ETSB CAD data is currently being fed to it. The UPS replacement for Lake Zurich is scheduled for August 12, 2020. A temporary loss of power is anticipated to last around five seconds during that time. ETSB Staff, Radicom, Nationwide Power, and Lake Zurich IT will all be onsite.
